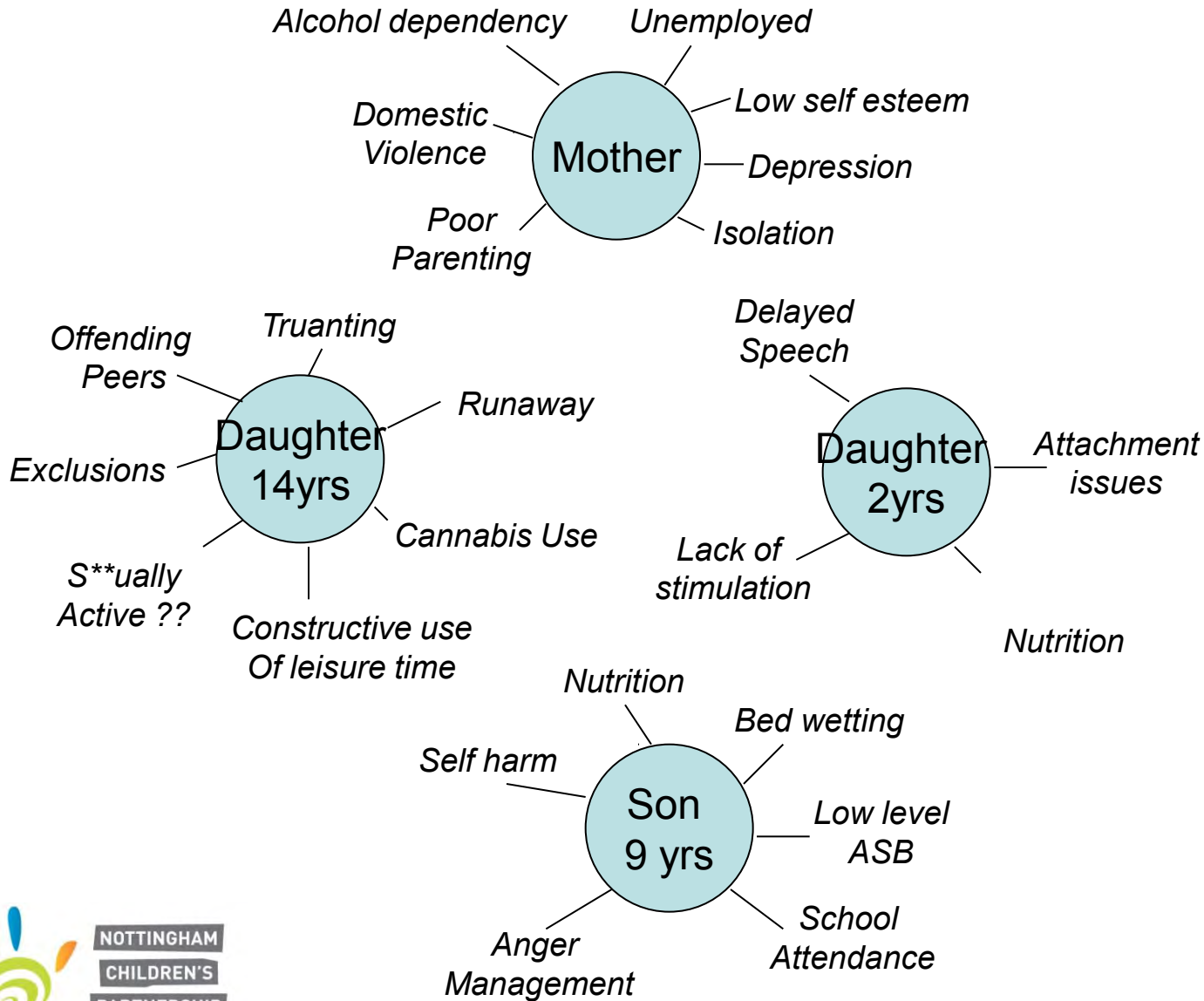
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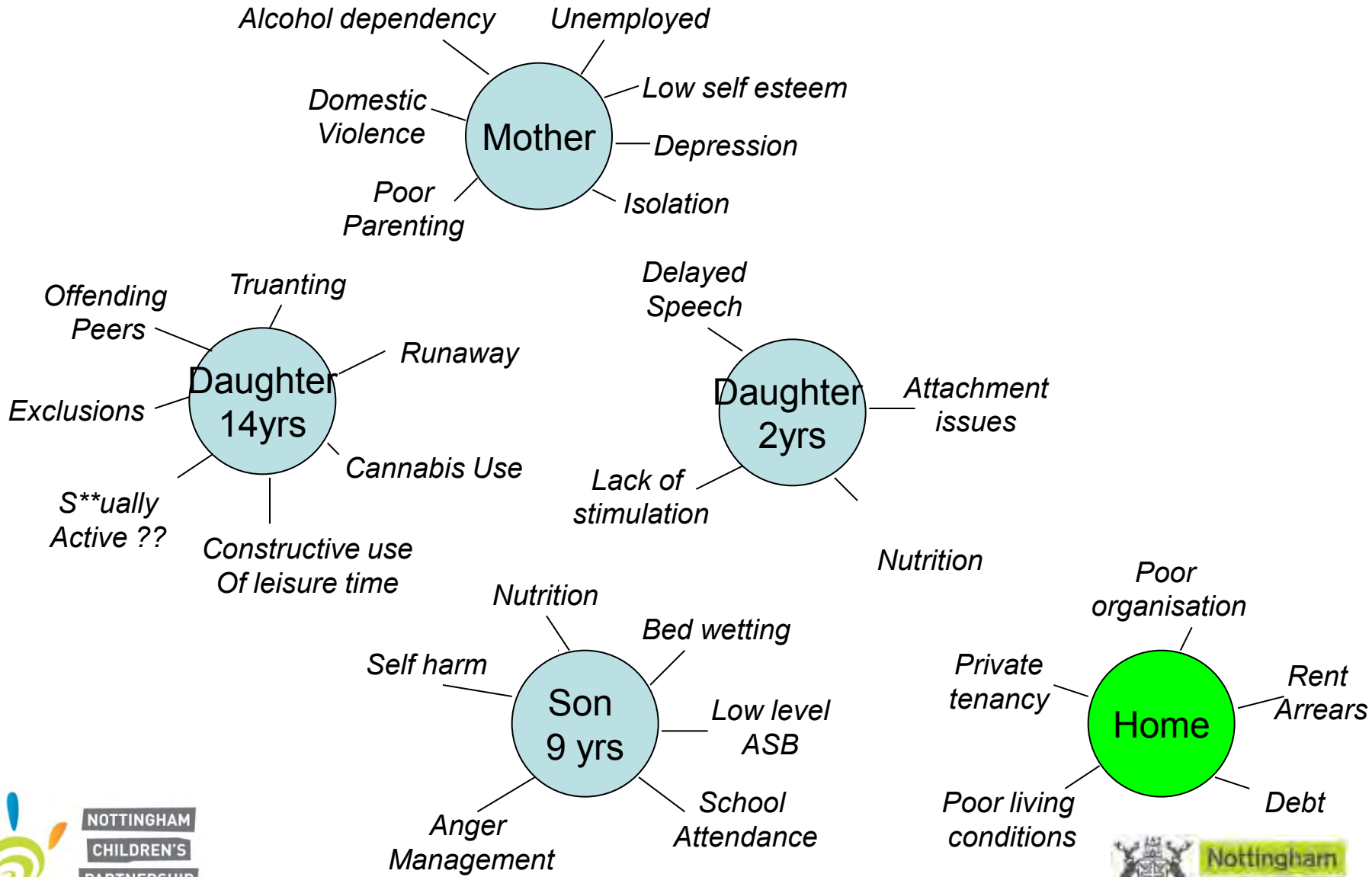
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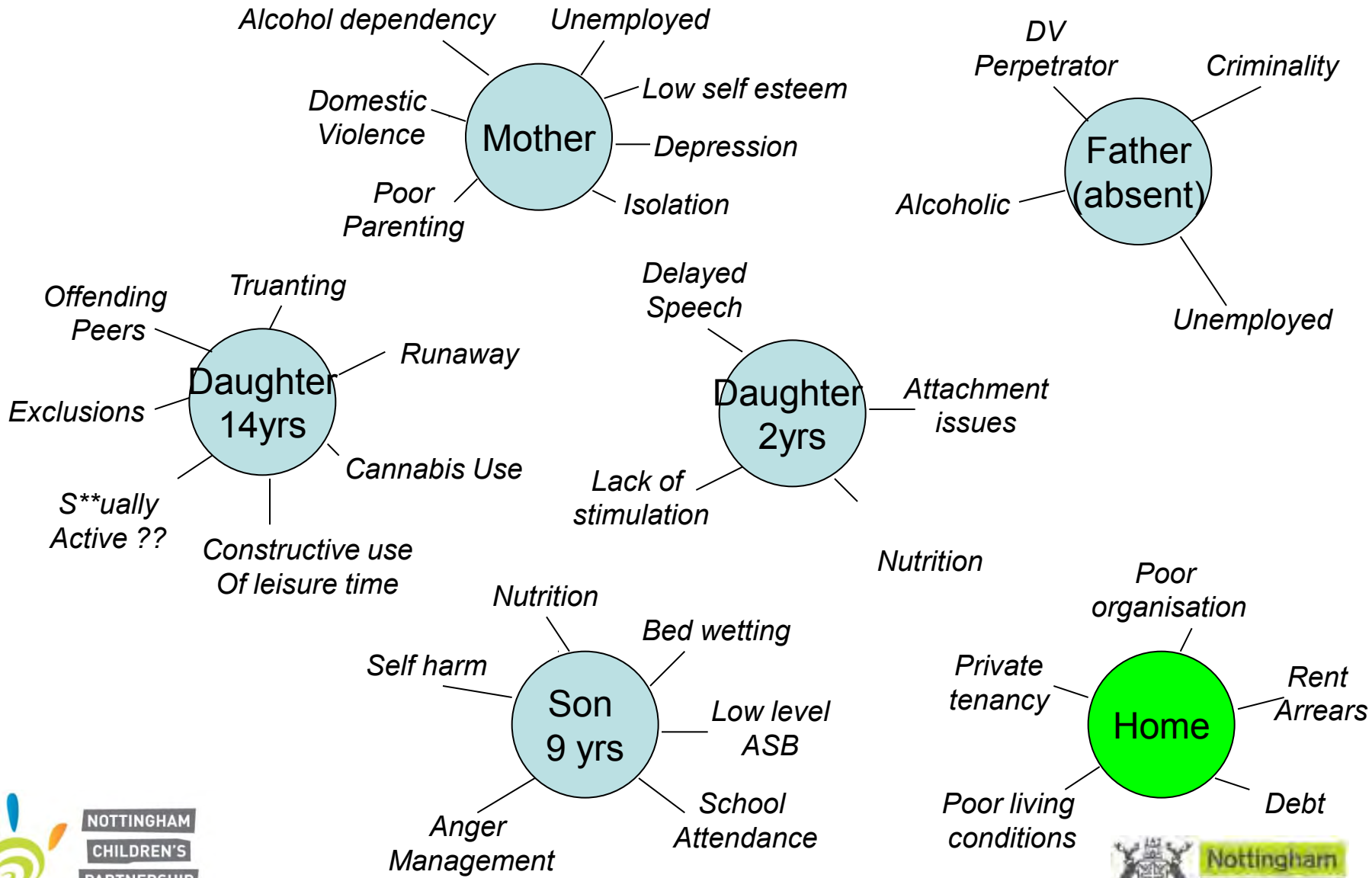
# Family Issues



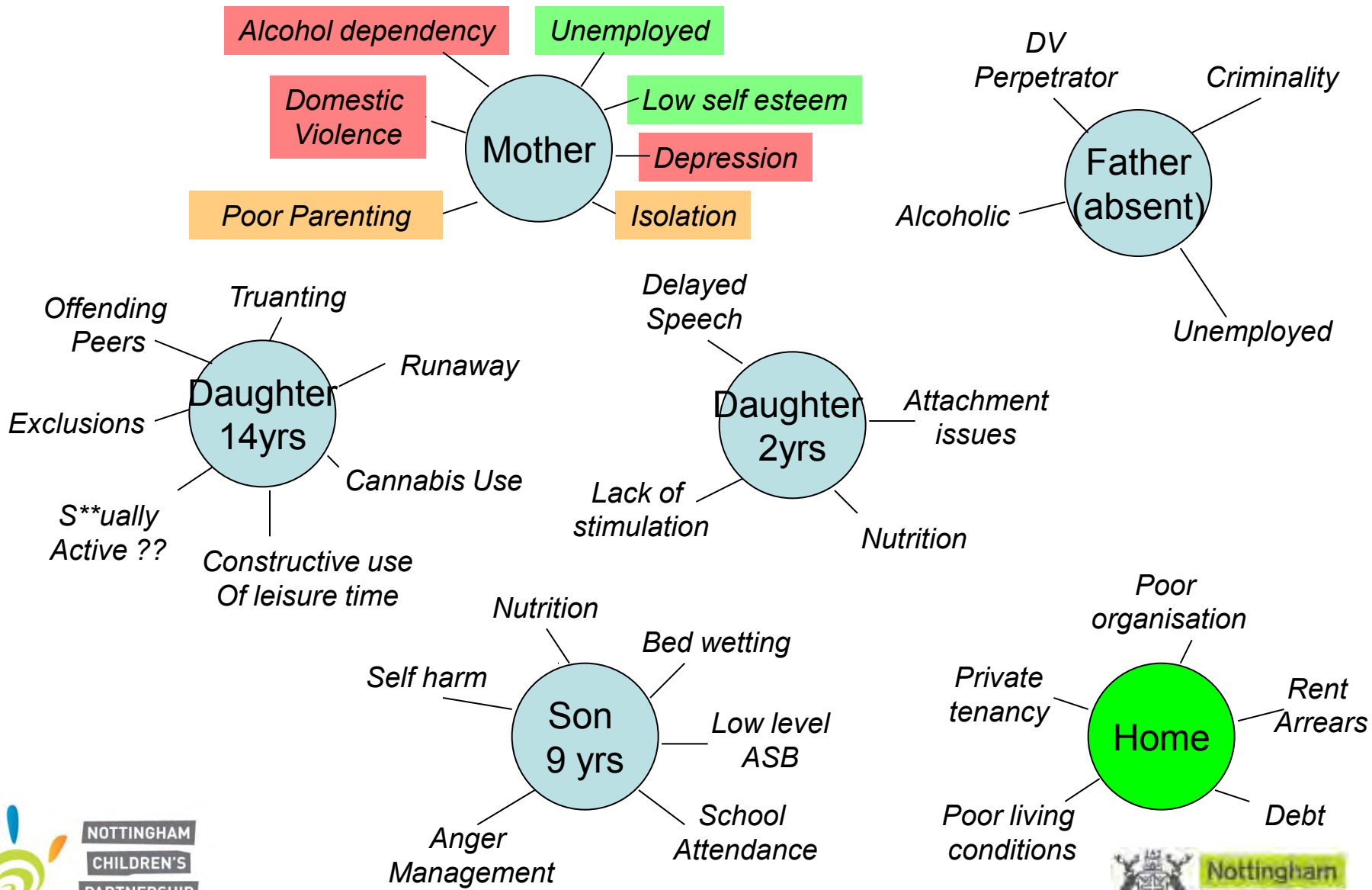
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Using a sample of **65 families** the following data is available:-

- **70%** of individual children (5-15) who presented as having school attendance issues have shown **an improvement** in their **school attendance**
- **70%** of women who presented as having been impacted by domestic violence have accessed education and support around **domestic violence**
- **55** children were subject to Child Protection Plan during the FIP intervention of which 50% are already improved/removed with a further % anticipated before exit.
- **65%** of families have **received** mental health intervention
- **54%** of families known **Anti-Social Behaviour has reduced** only families where all individuals within a family have reduced behaviour are included.
- **90%** of families have had their **benefits checked and updated**
- **80%** of family's functioning has improved
- Currently **4** families are subject to FIT tenancies.
- Of those families that are close to exit and who's tenancies were at risk **71%** are no longer at risk.

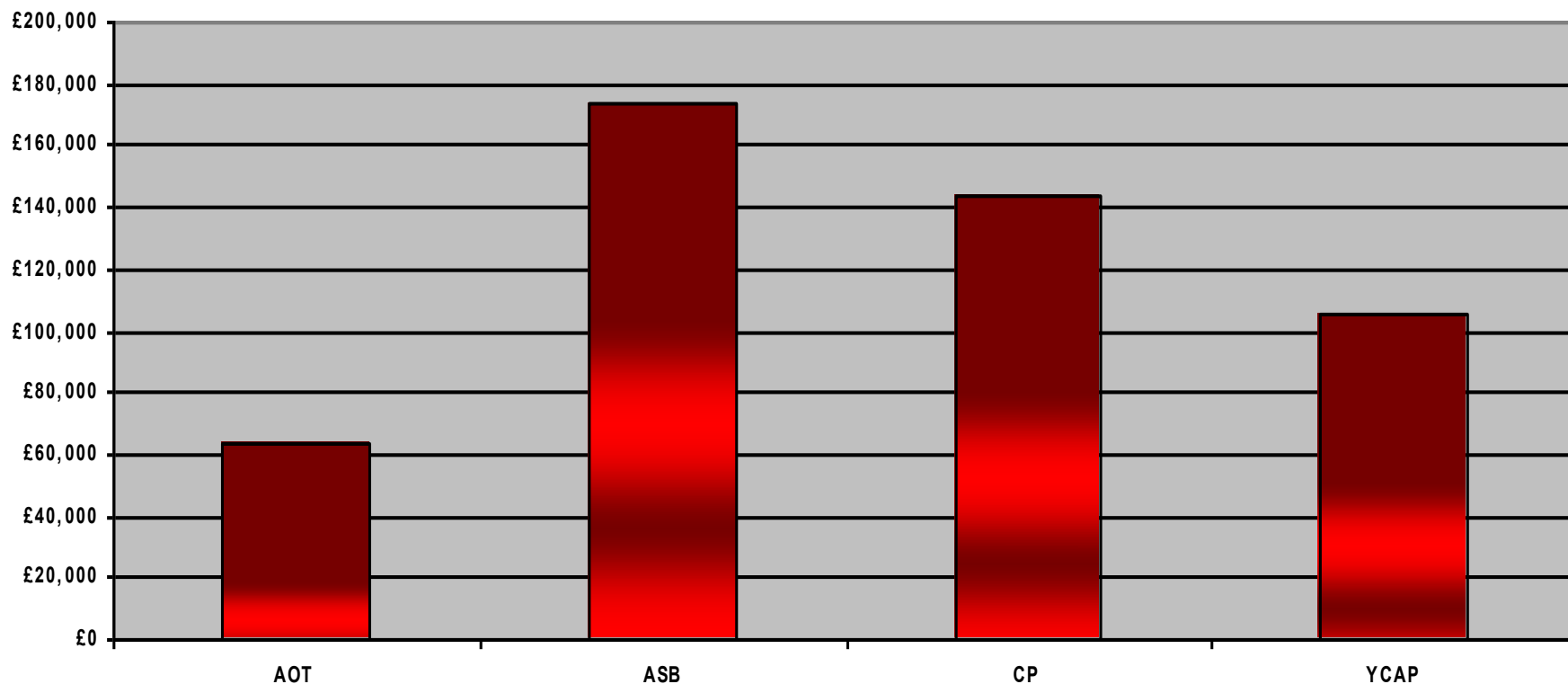
# Cost Savings and Cost Avoidance

41 families processed through the DfE Costing Tool by Independent Analyst:

- £5.3m cost savings across the 41 families
- £130K on average per family

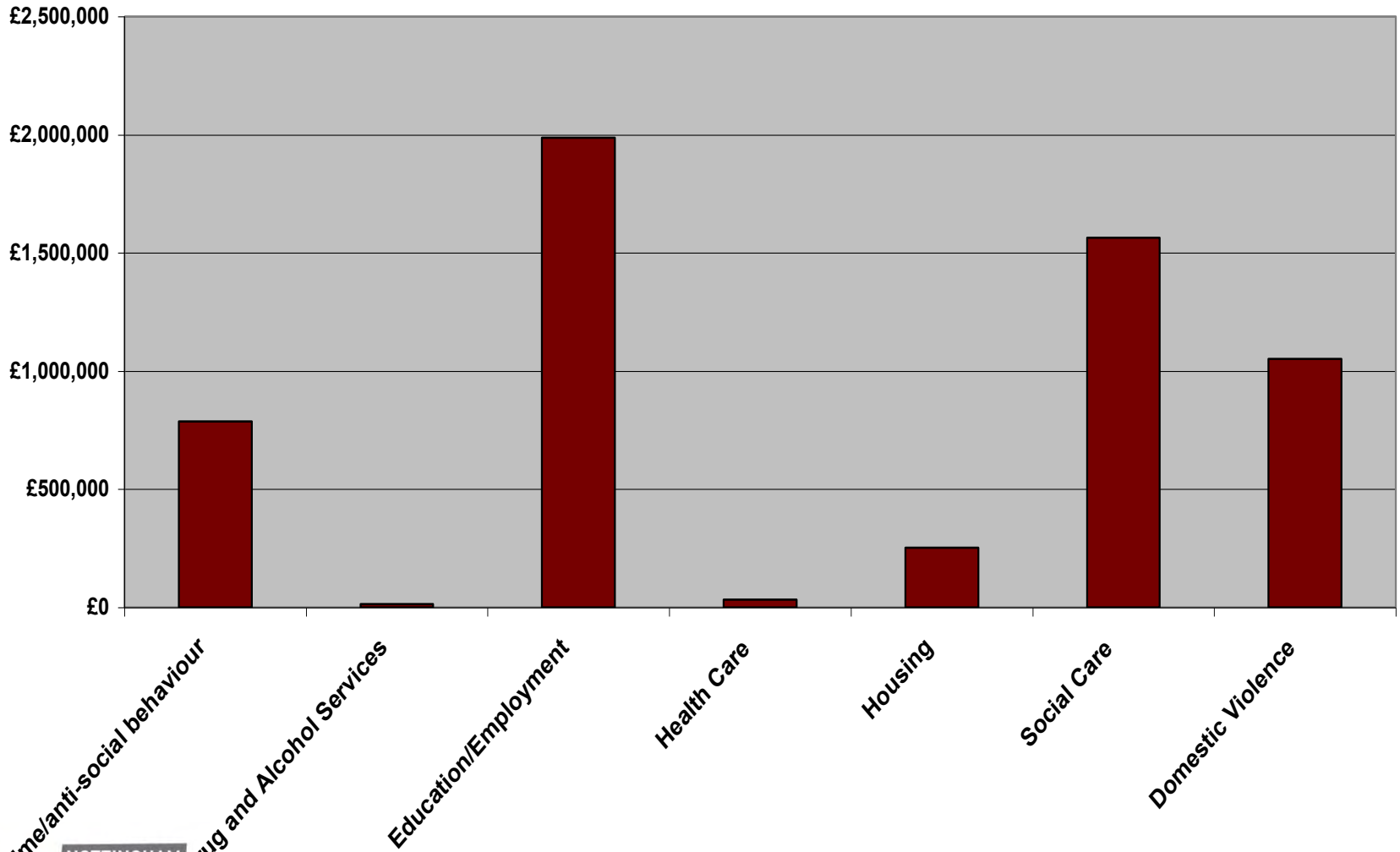
# Average cost savings per family by Referral (Team)

## Average Savings per Family by Category



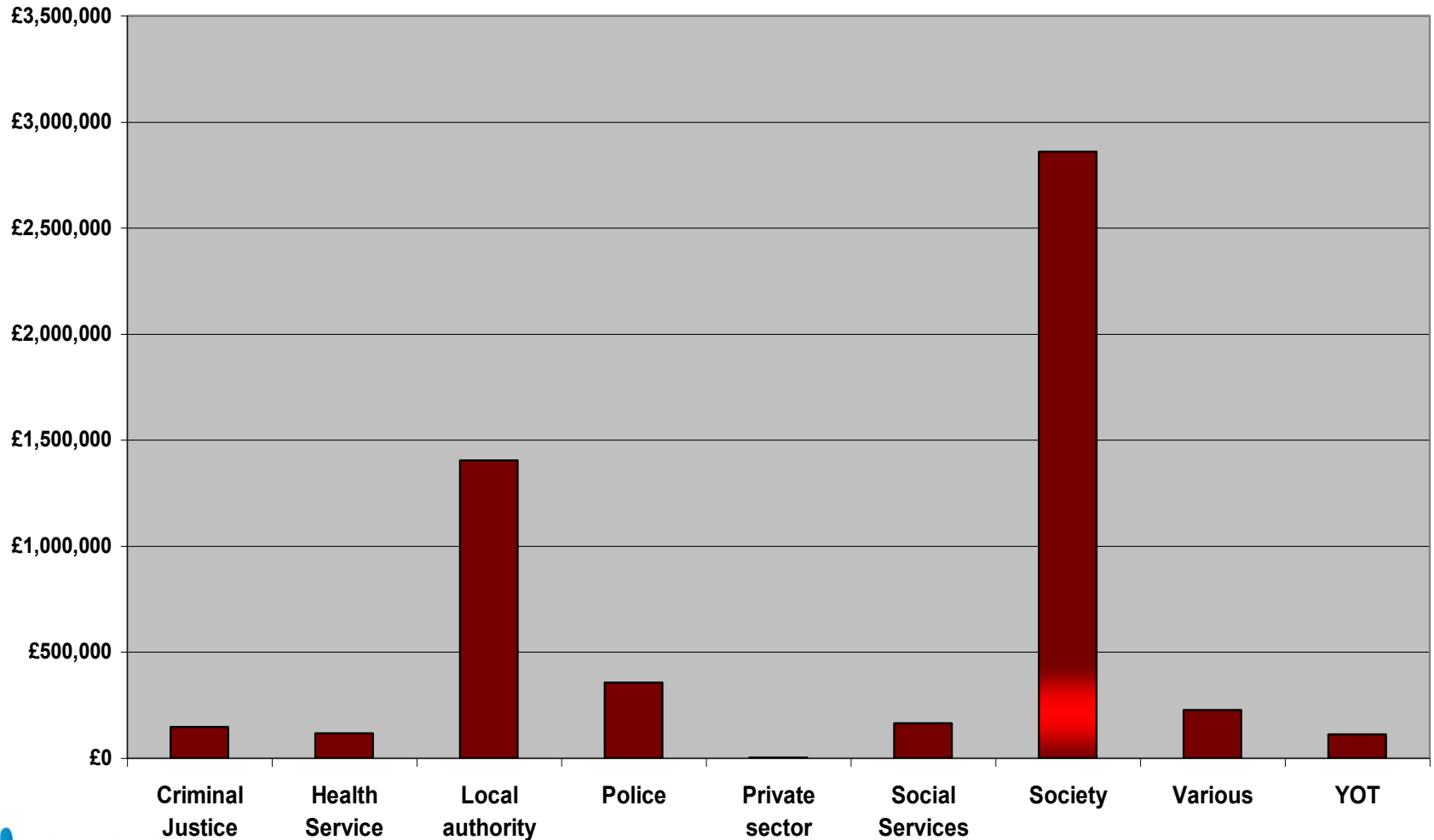
# Total Savings by Organisation

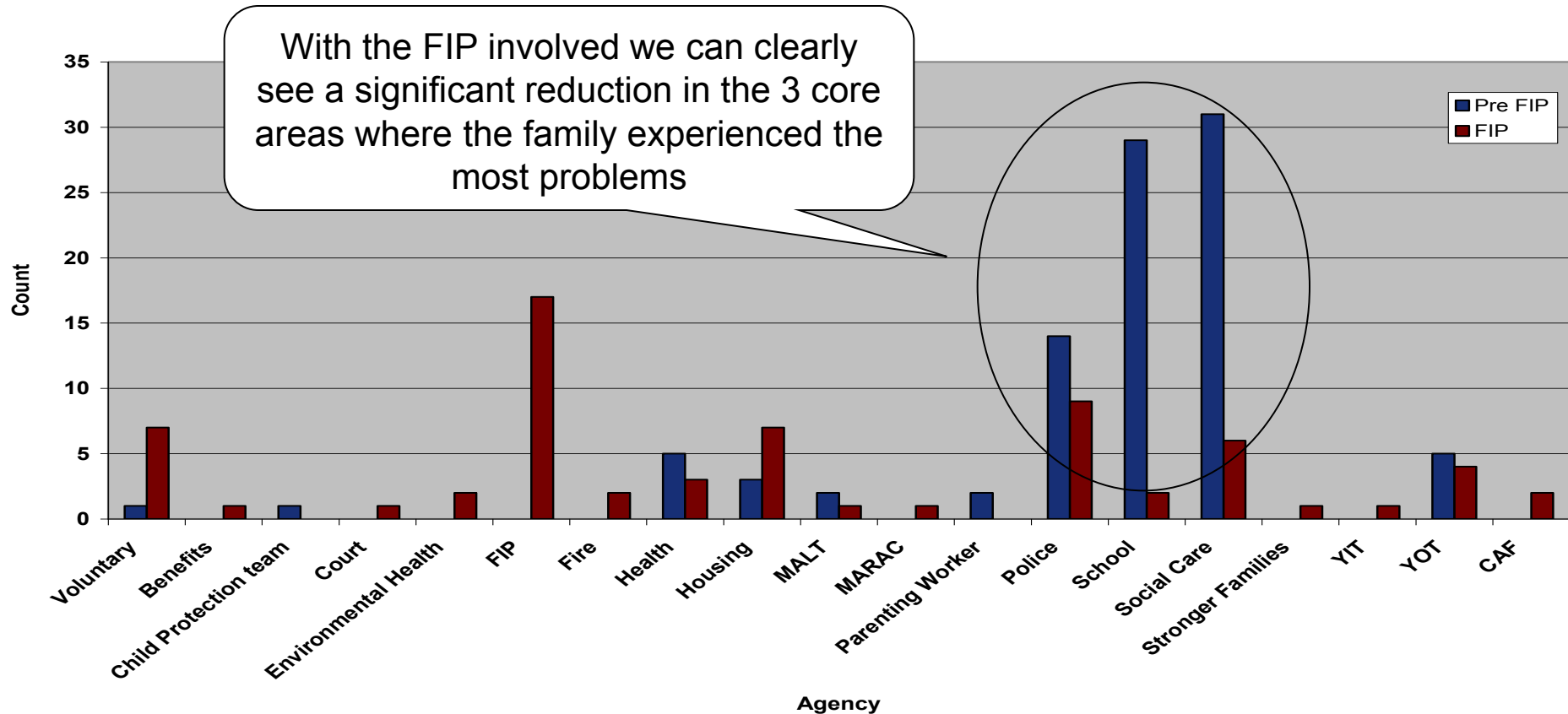


# Total Savings by Sector

# 2 Year Comparison of Service Involvement



The above graph highlights that as the FIP gets involved with a family and identifies the issues they are facing then this can lead to an increase in the number of services involved with the family. Though this does indicate an increased cost to start with this cost is targeted at resolving the issues identified and putting an end to sustained cost with no outcomes...

## And finally:-

- Mother with 10 children aged 2 -17 years
- Chaotic living conditions
- Significant offending and ASB (including £60K arson)
- History of Domestic Violence
- Mother alcohol dependent
- Acute school attendance issues
- Numerous referrals to Children's Social Care regarding neglect.
- Dysfunctional relationship with services (FTA's)
