Catch22 – Who we are

- Catch22 is a national charity
- Work to help young people, families and communities
- Present in 150 localities
- Employs 1,200 people and 650 volunteers
- Works directly with 37,000 service users p.a
- Turnover of £46m in 10/11
- Over 90% income from statutory sources

CTC - What is it?

- A process not a programme
- Early intervention and prevention programme
- Focused on risk and protective factors
- Working with Families, Communities, Individuals and Schools
- Evidence based
- Outcome focused
- Tested and effective

What does it do?

Phase 1

Community Readiness

- Identify and assess the readiness of an area to participate in a CtC project

Phase 2

Measuring & Partnerships

- Involve community and local professionals
- Training
- Risk and Protection audit
- Resource audit

Phase 3

Action Planning

- Collect evidence
- Identify relevant programmes
- Write Action Plan

Phase 4

Implementation

- Identify delivery agents
- Identify resources
- Implement programmes

Phase 5

Review

- Reassess levels of risk
- Evaluate impact
- Set new targets
- Return to phase 2
