- Working across England supporting all Local Authorities and their wider partners.

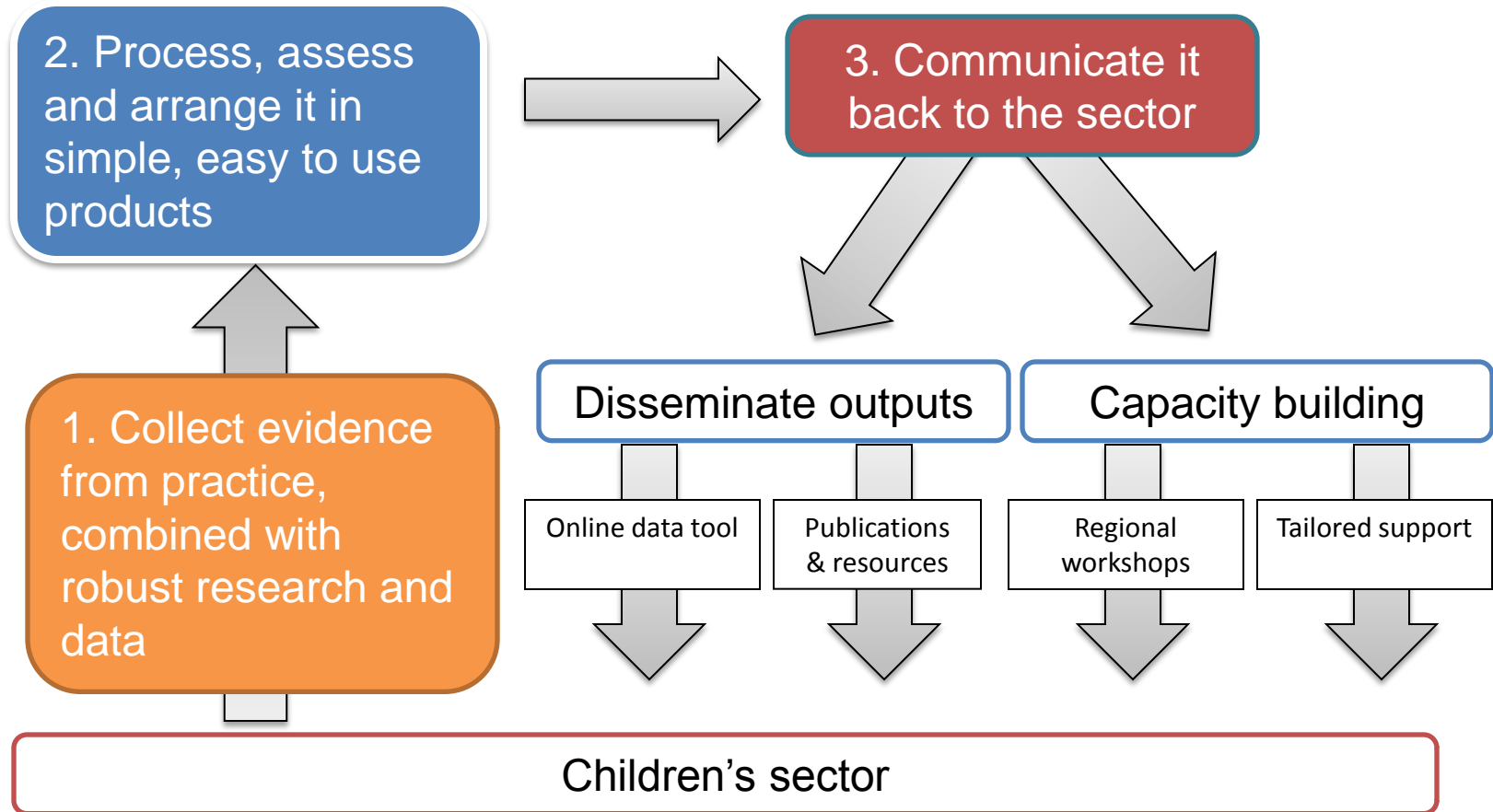
